Tournament Information

Rules: Mahjong Competition Rules published by the General Administration of Sport of China in 1998, as interpreted by the Mahjong International League (MIL), in the form of the tournament rules used by the China Majiang Federation (see CMF MCR Tournament Rules 2017) A pre-tournament briefing will be conducted for players unfamiliar with this version of the rules. The referees for this tournament will be supported by MIL.

Tournament format: A total of 8 games/sessions. Match-ups for the first game will be random. and will be according to rank (based on total table-point and competition-point scores) from the second game onwards.

Alloted time for each game: 110 minutes, on automatic tables. When the alloted time runs out, players still in play are allowed to finish the current hand, but cannot start a new hand.
